

FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION 2002-II
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FUNDING OF THE
FLOYD COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Solid Waste Management District has formulated its budget for fiscal year 2002, which budget has been approved or is pending approval by those local and state entities and agencies having jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, to assist the District in meeting its financial obligations and to avoid the necessity of imposing a property tax upon the residents of Floyd County for District purposes, is desirous of granting funds to the District pursuant to the provisions of IC 13-9.5-2-11.7.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd has included in its budget for calendar year 2002 the sum of \$250,000.00 for the use by the District; and


WHEREAS, at its regular meeting held on the 2nd day of January, 2002, the Board approved the transfer of said funds to the District, and by this resolution is desirous of formally confirming said approval.




NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd does hereby authorize and make a grant of funds to the Floyd County Solid Waste Management District in the amount not to exceed \$250,000.00 appropriated therefor in the 300 account of the general fund budget of said Board, such amount having been heretofore appropriated and approved for such purpose or will hereafter be additionally appropriated and approved therefor by the Floyd County Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon appropriation, the Floyd County Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to transfer said funds to the account of the District.
