

FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION 2004- VI

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION 2001-IX

WHEREAS, by Floyd County Resolution 2001-IX, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, with the concurrence of the Floyd County Council, proposed certain compensation to county employees who were called to active duty with the military forces of the United States as the result of the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Auditor has advised that as the active duty military compensation of those persons so called to active duty has exceeded that which would have been payable to said individuals had they continued as county employees, and as participation of said individuals in the medical and insurance programs offered to county employees is assured by other existing personnel policies, no person has been or will be benefited by Floyd County Resolution 2001-IX.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED, that Floyd County Resolution 2001-IX be, and the same is hereby rescinded, all to the extent and with the effect as if not enacted on the 16th day of October, 2001.
