A RESOLUTION PERMITTING THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO CLARK COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Sheriff has advised the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd (Board) that one of his patrol vehicles is no longer needed and necessary for law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Clark has indicated its desire to acquire said vehicles for use by the Clark County Sheriff and has proposed the payment of the sum of \$3,500.00 for the vehicle.

WHEREAS, for the price and under the terms agreed to, the Board is desirous of transferring said vehicle to Clark County, Indiana.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that upon the adoption by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Clark of a substantially identical resolution, the following described vehicle be transferred to Clark County, Indiana:

upon the payment of \$3,500.00 to the Floyd County Auditor for said vehicle.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon receipt and upon approval by the Floyd County Council, the funds received for said vehicle be transferred to account No. 0101-005-2000-04.
