WHEREAS, the right to effective assistance of counsel is guaranteed by the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of Indiana; and


WHEREAS, all indigent defense expenses are paid by the counties including the salary of chief public defenders and chief deputy defenders; and


WHEREAS, the state pays the salary and other compensation provided to judges; and


WHEREAS, the state pays the salary and other compensation provided to prosecuting attorneys chief deputy prosecuting attorneys;

BE IT RESOLVED, the County Commissioners of Floyd County urge the Indiana General Assembly to enact legislation that authorizes the state to pay the salaries and fringe benefits of chief public defenders and chief deputy public defenders, and appropriate an amount sufficient to pay for these positions.


