

A RESOLUTION PERMITTING THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN PROPERTY FROM FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA TO THE UNINCORPORATED CITY OF NEW ALBANY

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Sheriff has advised the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd (Board) that one of his patrol vehicles is no longer needed and necessary for law enforcement purposes and whereas the Board of Commissioners has set a price of \$2,500.00 for said vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Albany, Indiana has indicated through Civil City of New Albany Resolution 2007 – BOW 07-04, its desire to acquire said vehicle and has proposed the payment of the sum of \$2,500.00 for said vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of IC 36-1-11-8 permit the transfer of property between governmental entities for any amount of real property, cash or other personal property as agreed by such entities; and


WHEREAS, for the price and under the terms agreed to, the Board is desirous of transferring said vehicle to the City of New Albany, Indiana.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of New Albany shall acquire the 2004 Ford Crown Victoria, with VIN 2FAFP71W64X137734 for the sum of \$2,500.00.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Controller of the City of New Albany shall pay to the Floyd County Auditor \$2,500.00 for said vehicle.
