A RESOLUTION PERMITTING THE TRANSFER OF PROPERTY TO THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA

WHEREAS; the Floyd County Sheriff has advised the Floyd County Board of Commissioners that two (2) of the Sheriff patrol vehicles are no longer needed and necessary for law enforcement purposes: and

WHEREAS; the Town of Greenville has indicated their desire to acquire said vehicles for use by the Greenville Town Marshal and has proposed the payment of the sum of sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) for the two vehicles.

WHEREAS; the provisions of Indiana Code 36-1-11-8 permit the transfer of property between government entities for any amount of real property, cash or personal property as agreed by such entities; and

WHEREAS; for the price and under the terms agreed to, the Board of Commissioner's is desirous of transferring said vehicles to the Town of Greenville, Indiana.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED; that upon the adoption by the Floyd County Board of Commissioners the following described vehicle will be transferred to the Town of Greenville.

2012 Dodge Charger vin # 2C3CDXAT3CH280164

2013 Dodge Charger vin # 2C3CDXAT6DH673688

Upon payment of sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000.00) to the Floyd County Sheriff for said vehicles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon receipt of said funds and upon the approval of the Floyd County Council for an appropriation request, the funds will be deposited for said vehicles into the Sheriff's Special Vehicle and Equipment Fund (4910).
