## A RESOLUTION FOR THE FLOYD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REGARDING SPENDING FROM THE HOSPITAL FUNDS

WHEREAS, Floyd County (hereinafter, the "County") has sold its hospital and the proceeds exceeded \$130 million; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Council and the Floyd County Commissioners have agreed to adopt substantially similar resolutions concerning the spending of Hospital Funds (defined as, "annual spend rate of the Floyd County Fund and the annual distribution from the Baptist Health Network").

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Floyd County Commissioners agrees that

- 1. \$3.5 million shall be allocated from the Hospital funds to one or more County non-verting funds and/or the County Rainy Day Fund in order to assist with balancing the County's 2018 budget. See Exhibit "A" for allocation.
- 2. \$15 million shall be allocated from the Hospital funds to be used for the Floyd County Jail Project.
- 3. So resolved this 19<sup>th</sup> day of June, \$15 million shall be allocated from the Hospital funds to be used for the Floyd County Jail Project.
- 4. The County Council shall adopt this Resolution by July 10, 2018
