**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FLOYD
COUNTY, INDIANA CONCERNING CERTAIN MEMBERS OF
THE FLOYD COUNTY COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS
CARRYING FIREARMS IN THE CITY/COUNTY BUILDING**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County (the "Board") desires to allow certain members of the Floyd County Community Corrections to carry firearms in the City/County Building.

WHEREAS, FCO 2011 - V prohibits members of the general public to bring deadly weapons into the city/county building.

WHEREAS, FCO 2011 - V allows the Floyd County Commissioners the authority to permit certain individuals to carry weapons in the city/county building.

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Commissioners wish to make an exception and allow certain members of the Floyd County Community Corrections to carry firearms in the City/County Building.

WHEREAS, FCO 2011 - V allows the Floyd County Commissioners to give permission to carry firearms in the city/county building by resolution.

WHEREAS, certain members of the Floyd County Community Corrections need to carry firearms while on duty and acting within the scope of their employment as a Floyd County Community Corrections employee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS OF THE FLOYD COUNTY COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS ARE ALLOWED TO CARRY FIREARMS WHILE ON DUTY AND ACTING WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THEIR EMPLOYMENT AS A FLOYD COUNTY COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS EMPLOYEE AS WELL AS CARRY FIREARMS IN THE CITY/COUNTY BUILDING:






