CORRECTION: Plumbing should be maintained and in good repair. 430 Х X Observed ceiling tiles, dry wall, and flooring damaged by water leaks. 3 WEEKS CORRECTION: Damaged parts of the structure need to be replaced to keep the building in good repair. Shane stated the repairs were already scheduled. 431 Х Observed food debris and dirt build up on the walk-in cooler floor. 3 DAYS Observed mold on the coving under the ware-washing sink. CORRECTION: The physical facilities shall be cleaned as often as necessary to keep them clean. 294 Х Observed warm chlorine sanitizer of 10ppm. CORRECTION: Sanitizer 1 WEEK solution at 75F must have a minimum concentration of 50ppm Х 291 Observed expired test strips. CORRECTION: Testing strips must be 1 WEEK available for checking sanitizer concentrations. 218 Х Observed the double door freezer maintaining a temperature of 40F. CORRECTED CORRECTION: Food was moved to other cold holding units. If the mold continues to grow on the coving, I suggest replacing the coving with a more resistant material.
