0900 Daily Briefing;

The Grant County Health Department has reported **100, confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 5 deaths** in Grant County.

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) has identified 12,438 total presumptive positive cases of COVID-19 and 661 deaths and 69,470 tests in the state since Friday, March 6.

Marion Community Schools, weekly distribution will be each Wednesday, and MCS is currently planning to operate a weekly Point Of Distribution up to June 1st at this time.

The next MCS food distribution will be today April 22, from 4 to 6 PM.

The Salvation Army will be distributing food today as well at 10:00 AM

Also, 2nd Harvest food bank will be having a food distribution Saturday April 25th 2020 in the old Sears parking lot at five point's mall starting at 10:00 AM.
