

**RESOLUTION ON PROPOSED ORDINANCE MODIFYING
LOCAL INCOME TAX RATES IMPOSED IN MARTIN
COUNTY**

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Martin County, Indiana that a need now exists to modify the local income tax rates imposed within the county. As a member of the Martin County Local Income Tax Council, the Martin County Council is adopting this resolution in order to propose the ordinance below to the other members of the Martin County Local Income Tax Council.

**ORDINANCE MODIFYING LOCAL INCOME TAX RATES
IMPOSED IN MARTIN COUNTY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Council of Martin County, Indiana that a need now exists to modify the local income tax rates imposed within the county in the following way:

| Local Income Tax Type | Existing Rate | Proposed Rate |
|---------------------------------------|----------------------|----------------------|
| Property Tax Relief Rate (IC 6-3.6-5) | .25 | .25 |
| Expenditure Rate (IC 6-3.6-6) | | |
| Public Safety | .25 | .25 |
| Economic Development | .20 | .45 |
| Certified Shares | .80 | .80 |

The local income tax rates proposed above will become effective on January 1, 2018.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a public hearing was held on the proposed local income tax rate modification on October 16, 2017. Proper notice of the public hearing was provided pursuant to IC 5-3-1.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that by adopting this resolution, the Martin County Council is casting all of its Local Income Tax Council votes in favor of the proposed ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public hearing was held on this resolution and the proposed ordinance on October 16, 2017. Proper notice of the public hearing was provided pursuant to IC 5-3-1.
