

ORDINANCE NO. 2022- 31

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MARTIN COUNTY  
OPIOD SETTLEMENT FUNDS**

**WHEREAS**, Martin County is scheduled to receive settlement funds as part of the opiod settlement as negotiated between the State of Indiana and certain drug manufacturers and distributors on behalf of Martin County; and

**WHEREAS**, settlement funds shall be turned over to Martin County by the State of Indiana over a period of eighteen years, and

**WHEREAS**, there are established certain approved applications for the spending of said settlement funds by Martin County, and,

**WHEREAS**, the Indiana State Board of Accounts has determined the manner in which to account for settlement transactions for opiod settlement funds, and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County Indiana, as follows:

1. That the Martin County Opiod Restricted Fund, Fund Number 1237 is hereby established as part of the Martin County General Fund.


2. That the Martin County Opiod Unrestricted Fund, Fund Number 1238 is hereby established as part of the Martin County General Fund.

3. That the Martin County Auditor shall deposit all opiod settlement funds received by Martin County as a result of the opiod settlement negotiations into said respective Martin County Opiod Settlement Funds and a claim created against said Fund for the full reimbursement amount.


4. That following receipt into the County General Fund, all normal appropriation procedures shall apply toward said funds.


