RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION

RESOLUTION OF THE MARTIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, MARTIN COUNTY, INDIANA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN OWNER OCCUPIED REHABILITATION PILOT PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION TO THE INDIANA OFFICE OF COMMUNITY AND RURAL AFFAIRS AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners, Indiana recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners, Indiana has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low- and moderate-income residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Martin County Board of Commissioners, Indiana that:


1. The Commissioner President is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to complete an owner occupied housing rehabilitation project in the corporate limits, and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
2. Board of Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana hereby commits local funds in the amount of One Hundred Four Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Three Dollars (\$104,353.00) in the form of USDA Rural Development Housing Preservation Grant funds for said program, such commitment to be contingent upon receipt of CDBG OOR Pilot funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.


