

ORDINANCE NO. 2022- 4

**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MARTIN COUNTY  
LAW ENFORCEMENT SALARY DONATION FUND**

**WHEREAS**, there has been a donation by citizens of Martin County to be utilized to pay raises for Martin County Law Enforcement personnel; and

**WHEREAS**, the Indiana State Board of Accounts has stated that the governing body of a political entity must adopt in a public meeting an ordinance establishing a specific fund, and,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County Indiana, as follows:

1. That the Martin County Law Enforcement Salary Donation Fund, Fund Number 4106, is hereby established as part of the Martin County General Fund.

2. That the Martin County Auditor shall deposit all donations made to Martin County for the benefit of Law Enforcement Salaries into said Martin County Law Enforcement Salary Donation Fund and a claim created against said Fund for the full reimbursement amount.


3. That the money received into said Martin County Law Enforcement Salary Donation Fund shall be received into Martin County General Fund, Fund Number 4106.


4. That following receipt into the County General Fund, all normal appropriation procedures shall apply toward said funds.
