RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING OVERTIME PAY FOR MARTIN COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT JAILERS

WHEREAS, the Martin County Sheriff's Department operates a jail facility; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Martin County Sheriff's Department to employ jailers to supervise the operation of the Martin County Jail and the inmates retained therein; and

WHEREAS, the Martin County Sheriff's Department has regularly compensated Martin County Jailers for overtime work with compensatory hours; and

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners have been advised by the Sheriff of Martin County that due to difficulties in filling Jailer vacancies, it has become necessary for present Jailers to work overtime; and

WHEREAS, the Martin County Sheriff now requests that Jailers be paid overtime rather than be provided compensatory hours;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County Indiana, as follows:

- 1. That beginning January 1, 2023, Jailers employed by the Martin County Sheriff's Department that work greater than a forty (40) hours shift, shall be compensated with overtime pay as established by the Federal and State of Indiana Departments of Labor instead of said employees receiving compensatory hours.
- 2. That the issue of overtime pay for Jailers instead of compensatory hours shall not be a permanent resolution of this issue, but shall be revisited and reviewed on a monthly basis.
