Shall Smith-Green Community Schools continue to increase property taxes paid to the School Corporation for no more than eight (8) years for the purpose of funding and sustaining educational and operational stability in response to reductions in property tax revenue, maintaining health and safety initiatives, supporting and retaining teachers and staff, maintaining class sizes and transportation services, and funding academic and support programs to meet the educational needs of all students, while changing the current maximum operating referendum tax rate of \$0.6280, by imposing a property tax rate that does not exceed \$0.4988 and results in a maximum annual amount that does not exceed \$2,176,300? If this operating referendum public question is NOT approved by the voters, for a median residence of \$200,000, the property's annual tax bill would decrease by \$431 per year. 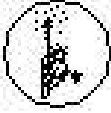
