(7) The volume of soil being excavated in excess of 1000 Cubic Yards (27,000 Cubic Feet).

Instructions for Determining Your Fee

The fees shall be calculated for both the type of development and the land disturbing activities. The higher of these two amounts shall be paid. The tables above show the per unit fee assessed with regard to this ordinance. Table 3A shows the fee schedule for New Developments. Table 3B shows the fee schedule for Remodeling, Additions to an Existing Structure, or New Construction on a Previously Platted Tract. Table 3C shows

the fee schedule for Land Disturbing Activities. The required fee shall be the higher of either Table 3A, Table 3B, or Table 3C (whichever is applicable).

Permit fee for the installation of Geothermal Open Loop Discharge Line is \$75.00. Fee is applicable for both new construction and repair of existing open loop geothermal systems. Note: All geothermal applications shall include a site plan with an acceptable discharge outlet in accordance with the Noble County Storm Drainage and Erosion Control Ordinance.
