## AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 2021-03A

## CREATING A NEW FUND FOR THE RECEIPT OF FUNDING FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN AS ADOPTED BY CONGRESS IN 2021

**WHEREAS**, the federal government has adopted the American Rescue Plan (ARP) which has been signed into law by the President; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a new fund in the Auditor's Office into which the proceeds of the ARP are to be deposited;

WHEREAS, the Parke County Board of Commissioners previously passed Ordinance No. 2021-\_\_\_\_ on May 3, 2021 addressing the creation of this fund but now wish to amend said ordinance to modify paragraph 2(d) to specifically include roads/highways as infrastructure.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PARKE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

- 1. That the Parke County Auditor shall create a fund entitled "ARP Grant Fund", and the Auditor has issued a fund number of \_\_\_\_\_ with respect to these funds and such funds shall be non-reverting.
- 2. The purpose of the fund is to be used for only the following reasons as set forth in §603(C) of the ARP in accordance with US Treasury Guidance:
  - a. To respond to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) or its negative economic impacts, including assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits, or to aid impacted industries such as tourism, travel and hospitality; and
  - b. To respond to workers performing essential work during the COVID-19 public health emergency by providing premium pay to eligible works of eligible towns, non-entitlement units of local government or the county that are performing such essentials, or by providing grants to eligible employers that employ eligible workers who perform essential work; and
  - c. For the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue of such eligible towns, non-entitlement units of local government, or county due to the COVID-19 public health emergency relative to revenues collected in the most recent full fiscal year of the eligible town, non-entitlement unit of local government or county prior to the emergency; or
  - d. To make necessary investments in infrastructure including but not limited to water, sewer, broadband and road/highway infrastructure as approved by the US. Treasury.
  - 3. The funds shall be appropriated by the County's fiscal body before use.
  - 4. All expenditures of funds shall be approved by the Board of Commissioners with any and all claims to be paid from the County's ARP fund.
  - 5. The Board of Commissioners will establish the plans, conditions and rules upon which the funds are to be requested and used.

- 6. Any unused funds shall be paid back to the United States Treasury when
- 7. The Auditor shall keep accurate and complete financial records of the receipts and expenditures of any and all funds deposited and paid from this new Fund.
- 8. No money received in the ARP fund shall be used for any type of deposit into any pension fund.
