WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for Parke County, IN have been advised of funding available from the Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA) designated as the OCRA COVID-19 RECOVERY PHASE 3 GRANT which is available to aid organizations such as the Food Security Alliance in combatting hunger; and
