Topics may include advanced nuclear technologies, including small modular reactors; the nuclear-energy ecosystem; potential community and economic impacts; and the requirements and meaning of an Advanced Nuclear Ready Community designation.

Members of the Spencer County Board of Commissioners, Spencer County Council, and other public bodies or county officials may be present. To the extent a majority of any governing body is present, this notice is also intended to constitute notice of a public meeting under Indiana's Open Door Law. No final action will be taken at either open house.
