The Switzerland County Board of Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to law and by being duly advertised.

Those present – Commissioners: Ryan Harrison, Jamie Peters and Joe Bennett, Gayle Sullivan, Auditor County Attorney Garrett Bascom. Dusty Hunt -Hwy Superintendent.

Ryan called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of minutes from September 15, 2025 regular meeting. Joe made a motion and Jamie second. All in favor

Approval of claims. Jamie made a motion to approve claims as presented and Joe made a second. All in favor.

Hwy Superintendent-Dusty Hunt

- Town of Patriot has requested long arm mowing on Foxtail Lane-is that ok? **All three commissioners are ok with this.**
- Fog seal has been completed
- Crews have been mowing, spreading rock and grading roads as necessary
- Just a reminder-Fall Cleanup is this weekend, 10/10, 11 & 12
- We submitted our application for the 2026-1 CCMG call that opened October 1st. Requested \$858,396 which is 80% of \$1,072,995. Should hear by the end of the year if we are awarded the funds. Our 20% match will be \$214,599. Discussion was had about the wheel tax and when that may take place.
- 9/24-Hilltop notified us they will no longer be supplying chips starting in 2026
- We participated in Touch A Truck for the school on 9/26. Posted some pictures on Facebook & website
- Sent out request for quotes on EMS parking lot paving-use refund from Stryker



 - f. Wesley spoke about what the insurance needs from the county to meet their standards. Spoke detectors at the highway and roof at the Tech building.


