

REGULAR MEETING –MONDAY AT 5:00 P.M.

The Switzerland County Board of Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to law and by being duly advertised.

Those present – Commissioners: Ryan Harrison, Jamie Peters and Joe Bennett, County Dusty Hunt -Hwy Superintendent. Gayle Sullivan-Auditor. Garrett Bascom-County Attorney.

Ryan called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of minutes from March 16, 2026 meeting. Joe made a motion and Ryan second. All in favor.

Approval of claims. Joe made a motion to approve claims as presented and Ryan made a second. All in favor.

Cumulative Capital Development Fund

Ryan read ordinance 4-6-26-6-Fund states that the cum cap rate will be moved to \$0.0333. Ryan made a motion to pass with Joe second. All in favor.

Hwy Superintendent-Dusty Hunt

- Bulger Tapp engineering proposal- Ryan made a motion to approve Gonzalez company and not to exceed \$19,240 and Joe second. All in favor.
- Spring Cleanup planned for Friday-Sunday May 1st thru 3rd. Town of Vevay will try and do the same. Joe made a motion to use the dates May 1st-3rd and to have five dumpsters and one dumpster for scrap. Ryan second. All in favor.
- Crews have been hauling chips for chip and seal work and stockpiling 53B's for shoulder work on Antioch
- 3 Backhoes-thoughts on this. Discussion was had about the possibility of financing. The need and cost of the three were discussed. Possibly the \$150,000.00 from commissioners and the \$140,000.00 from highway and ask for the balance from council. Also, the discussion of buying all three at the same time would be a savings of \$47,000-\$48,000. Ryan made a motion to purchase two backhoes from Commissioners casino fund if the balance is \$1,470,000.00 and highway purchase the third. Jamie second. All in favor.
- Poling road-1 mile back it becomes gravel. The three property owners would like to have a gate put up to keep people from going all the way back to the end. Landowners will have to have adjoining land owners served before the public hearing.

- a. Lifetime Resources-Erin Thomas came and spoke on behalf of Lifetime Resources. Resolution needed from county designated Lifetime Resources as the public transit services. Ryan made a motion to approve and Jamie second. All in favor.

- b. Patty Jackson-Bids OCRA grant-Property address of 1193 Rosenberg Road: Stehlin Construction \$32597.00 and Jackson Construction \$28,442.00. Ryan made a motion to approve Jackson Construction with a bid of \$28,442.00 and Joe second. All in favor.
- c. John Kniola-March 18 about 18 mature trees were cut down at Bryant's Creek Park. Spoke to a couple of people and it was stated that the Commissioners own it. John asked if Commissioners have any comments.
- d. Automatic door-handicap access-Ryan signed off on the quote.
- e. Mowing quotes/bids. Due 2 weeks from today.


