Ryan called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of minutes from July 21, 2025 executive meeting. Ryan made a motion and Joe second. All in favor

Approval of claims. Jamie made a motion to approve claims as presented and Joe made a second. All in favor.

- Carrol Turner Rd-Garrett spoke about the road and all criteria being met. He will prepare an ordinance for the next meeting.

- a. Herschel Brichto & Mary McCarty-SIRPC-spoke about grants for comprehensive planning. Mary spoke about what they have to offer and ways they can help with the overall cost. Discussion was had about the grants and what would be required from the county.
- b. Everbridge contract-Ryan made motion to not renew the contract and Joe made a second. All in favor.
- c. John Kniola-Thursday July 10th we had a regular meeting and excepted a resignation from a board member. Passed a skinny budget for 2026. Expecting to ask Nucor for \$16,000.00 + resurface parking lot at Markland Park. Sunday July 13th someone did donuts at Patriot Park and will be approximately \$1200.00. Spoke to Brian about possible criminal charges. Things look good at Bryant's Creek. Town of Vevay still has inoperable vehicles.
- d. Ryan Secord- would like to get the ancillaries, such as dental, vision and life for the county. Instead of paying two brokers the county would pay just one. Discussion was had the possibilities of savings for the county. Jamie made a motion to appoint Henriott group as our insurance

- representative concerning all insurance for county employees. Ryan second. All in favor
- e. Ryan Everman-request to transfer funds-Transfer funds in the amount of \$25,000.00 (3100.00) put \$15,000.00 to PRN and \$10,000.00 to OT line. Jamie made a motion to approve the transfer and Joe made a second. All in favor. Ryan also asked about the parking lot for SCER. Ryan asked if Dusty would look at it first.
- f. Bid for front porch steps-only had one quote and commissioners asked Wesley to get at least another quote.
- g. Gayle asked about payment for AOD. Jamie asked that it be taken from the Commissioner's contract line item. Also asked about the \$500.00 stipend for employees that was agreed tom last year. Line item for 2026 added to commissioner's budget. Ryan made a motion to pay up to \$2000.00 out of the commissioner's casino budget. Joe second. All in favor. Going forward put \$6,000.00 in a line item on commissioner's website.

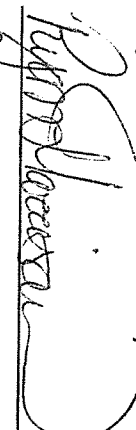
