THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85- 03, 2011 AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS (Hanging Rock Road, speed limit)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that the speed limit on Hanging Rock Road starting at a point three thousand one hundred forty-one (3,141) feet east of its intersection with State Road 524 and continuing east for a distance of one thousand two hundred fifty (1,250) feet should be reduced to thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The speed limit on three thousand one hundred forty-one (3,141) feet east of its intersection with State Road 524 and continuing east for a distance of one thousand two hundred fifty (1,250) feet shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour.
- 2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C infraction.
- 3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.
