AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2005-4 CREATING THE WABASH COUNTY IDENTIFICATION SECURITY PROTECTION FUND

Under I.C. 36-2-7.5-11, by ordinance 2005-4, the Council established the Identification Security Protection Fund ("Fund").

To reflect amendments to I.C. 36-2-7.5-11, the Council desires to amend Ordinance 2005-4.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED THAT ORDINANCE 2005-4 IS NOW AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Wabash County Identification Security Protection Fund shall continue in existence.
- 2. Deposits to this Fund shall consist of monies collected by the County Recorder from the identification security protection fee under I.C. 36-2-7.5-6(c)(2).
 - 3. The County Council shall appropriate money from the Fund.
- 4. The money in the Fund may be used by the County Recorder only to purchase, upgrade, implement, or maintain redacting technology used in the office of the County Recorder.
