

Full-Time Public Retirement (FTPR)

Full-Time Public Retirement (FTPR) employees are those who are not in a part-time or temporary status and who are regularly scheduled to work at the County's full-time schedule of at least thirty-five (35) hours or more per workweek. FTPR employees are eligible for the County's benefit package, subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations of each benefit program.

- Paid Jury Duty leave

- EAP (employee assistance program)
- Deferred Compensation Plan (457B)
- Supplemental Group Coverage through The Standard
