Order Appointing Judges Pro Tempore

The Honorable Michael J. Kramer, Judge of the Noble Circuit Court, has notified this Court that he will temporarily be unable to perform the duties of his office, effective May 7, 2018. We find that in the interest of continuing the orderly administration of justice and pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Judges *Pro Tempore* should be appointed temporarily to discharge the duties of judge of the Noble Circuit Court. Senior Judges G. David Laur and George E. Brown, Jr. have indicated their willingness to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Noble Circuit Court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Senior Judge G. David Laur is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Noble Circuit Court, effective May 7 through May 31, 2018, and that Senior Judge George E. Brown, Jr. is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Noble Circuit Court, effective June 1, 2018, and shall remain as Judge *Pro Tempore* until this Court issues a further Order.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judges Laur and Brown to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Noble Circuit Court. Judges Laur and Brown shall be entitled to compensation for their service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of their appointments, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
