

Order Assigning Judge Pro Tempore

The Court has been informed of the resignation of the Honorable Chris A. Wrede, Judge of the Terre Haute City Court. As a result, we find that in the interest of continuing the orderly administration of justice and pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, a Judge *Pro Tempore* should be appointed temporarily to discharge the duties of judge of the Terre Haute City Court. Further, this Court has been advised that Kim Jackson, an attorney licensed to practice in Indiana, is willing to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Kim Jackson is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Terre Haute City Court effective August 13, 2018 and upon her filing of an appropriate written oath. This appointment shall remain effective until a successor judge assumes the office or further Order of this Court, whichever occurs first.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Jackson to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Terre Haute City Court. Commencing from the effective date of her appointment, Judge Jackson shall be entitled to compensation for her service, as provided in Trial Rule 63(D), paid from the funds of the City of Terre Haute at the same rate and on the same schedule as applied to Judge Wrede.
