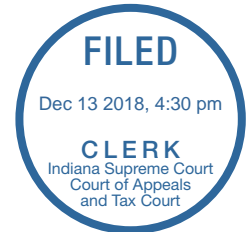

Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable Jason M. Mount, Judge of the Scott Circuit Court, has notified this Court that he will temporarily be unable to perform the duties of his office, effective December 12, 2018. We find that in the interest of continuing the orderly administration of justice and pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, a Judge *Pro Tempore* should be appointed temporarily to discharge the duties of judge of the Scott Circuit Court. Senior Judge Alison T. Frazier has indicated her willingness to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Scott Circuit Court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Senior Judge Alison T. Frazier is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Scott Circuit Court, effective December 13, 2018, and shall remain as Judge *Pro Tempore* until this Court issues a further Order.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Frazier to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Scott Circuit Court. Judge Frazier shall be entitled to compensation for her service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of her appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
