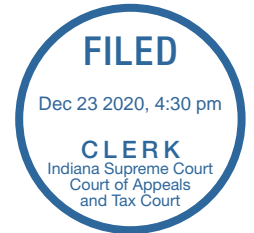

Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable Michael J. Kramer, Judge of the Noble Circuit Court, has notified this Court that he will temporarily be unable to perform the duties of his office due to health reasons, effective December 28, 2020. Senior Judge G. David Laur has indicated willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in the Noble Circuit Court, beginning on December 28, 2020.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge G. David Laur is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in the Noble Circuit Court, effective December 28, 2020, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Laur to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Noble Circuit Court until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Laur shall be entitled to compensation for his service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
