Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

Judge Sheryl L. Lynch of the Marion County Circuit Court, has notified this Court that she is taking a medical leave of absence. Senior Judge Jeffrey C. Eggers has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore, in the Marion Circuit Court, beginning on August 30, 2021.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Jeffrey C. Eggers is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in the Marion Circuit Court, effective August 30, 2021, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Eggers to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Marion Circuit Court until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Eggers shall be entitled to compensation for his service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
