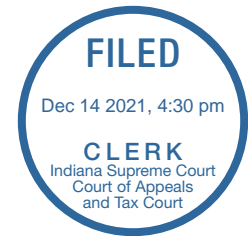

Order Revoking Judge Pro Tempore Appointment

The Honorable Sheryl L. Lynch, Judge of the Marion County Circuit Court, previously notified this Court that she would be unable to perform the duties of her office due to health reasons. On August 26, 2021, Senior Judge Jeffrey C. Eggers was appointed to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in the Marion County Circuit Court, beginning on August 30, 2021. Judge Lynch has provided notice of her intent to retire. Judge Lynch retires on December 31, 2021. The Honorable Tiffany U. Vivo has been appointed as Judge of the Marion County Circuit Court. Judge Vivo has notified this court that she is prepared to assume the duties of Marion County Circuit Court beginning on January 1, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Senior Judge Jeffrey C. Eggers' appointment as Judge Pro Tempore in the Marion Circuit Court, will end effective January 1, 2022, and Judge Vivo will assume the duties of her office.
