Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The St. Joseph Superior Court, has notified this Court that there is a vacancy awaiting judicial appointment. Senior Judge Jane W. Miller is currently serving as senior judge in this Superior Court and has indicated willingness to continue serve as Judge Pro Tempore, in the same St. Joseph Superior Court, beginning on February 15, 2021.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Jane Miller is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in the St. Joseph Superior Court, effective February 15, 2021, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until May 1, 2021.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Miller to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the St. Joseph Superior Court until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Miller shall be entitled to compensation for her service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
