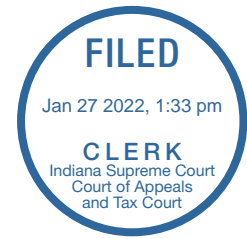

Order Revoking Judge Pro Tempore Appointment

The Honorable Steven L. Hostetler retired on September 3, 2021, creating a vacancy in St. Joseph Superior Court 7. In the interest of continuing the orderly administration of justice pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, on August 17, 2021, Senior Judge Mary Beth Bonaventura was appointed as Judge Pro Tempore, beginning on September 7, 2021, to discharge the duties of judge of St. Joseph Superior Court 7, until the process for filling the vacancy was complete and a new judge was sworn in.

On December 30, 2021, the vacancy was filled when Governor Eric J. Holcomb announced Mark Telloyan as his judicial appointment to the St. Joseph Superior Court. The St. Joseph Superior Court has notified this Court that Mr. Telloyan will be sworn in on February 14, 2022, and that Mr. Telloyan is prepared to discharge the duties of judge of St. Joseph Superior Court 7 beginning on February 14, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Senior Judge Mary Beth Bonaventura's appointment as Judge Pro Tempore in the St. Joseph Superior Court 7 shall be revoked and end at the conclusion of February 6, 2022. Senior judges will preside over St. Joseph Superior Court 7 between February 7, 2022 and February 13, 2022, until Mr. Telloyan is sworn in on February 14, 2022.
