Order Allocating Senior Judge Service Days to Clark Superior Courts 5 & 6

On December 14, 2021, this Court issued an Order, Appointing Senior Judges and Allocating Senior Judge Service Days. Clark County Superior Court 5 and Clark County Superior Court 6 did not receive an allocation of senior judge services days in the aforementioned order. IT IS, THEREFORE ORDERED that both Clark Superior Court 5 and Clark Superior Court 6 shall each receive an initial allotment of 30 service days for 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, FURTHER ORDERED that both Clark Superior Court 5 and Clark Superior Court 6 may use the number of senior judge days specified without any additional request to this Court. It shall be incumbent upon the presiding judge of each court to ensure that their court complies with the requirements laid out in the December 14, 2021, Allotment Order.
