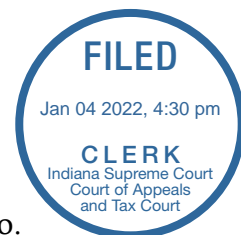

Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable Karen M. Love, Judge of the Hendricks Superior Court Div. 3, has provided notice that she will be periodically unavailable to fulfill her duties due to upcoming medical treatments beginning on January 10, 2022. Judge Mark Jones expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in the Hendricks Superior Court Div. 3, until February 23, 2022. Judge Jones has agreed to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in the Hendricks Superior Court Div. 3 beginning on January 10, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Mark Jones is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in the Hendricks Superior Court Div. 3, effective January 10, 2022, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until February 23, 2022.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Jones to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Hendricks Superior Court Div. 3. Judge Jones shall be entitled to compensation for his service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
