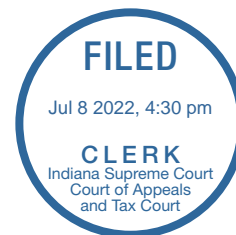

Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

Judge Murielle S. Bright of the Jennings Circuit Court, notified this Court that she will be taking maternity leave, effective August 8, 2022. Judge Jonathan W. Webster has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore, in the Jennings Circuit Court, beginning on August 8, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Judge Jonathan W. Webster is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in Jennings Circuit Court, effective August 8, 2022, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Webster to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of Jennings Circuit Court until further order of this Court. Judge Webster shall be entitled to compensation for his service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
