Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

Judge Daniel E. Moore of the Clark County Circuit Court 1, has notified this Court that he is taking a medical leave of absence. Senior Judge Susan L. Orth has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore, in the Clark Circuit Court 1, beginning on January 26, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Susan L. Orth is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in the Clark Circuit Court 1, effective January 26, 2022, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Orth to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Clark Circuit Court 1 until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Orth shall be entitled to compensation for her service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of her appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
