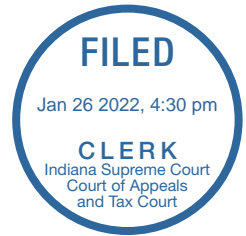

Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

Judge Mark Jones of the Marion County Superior Court 15, retired from the bench on January 8, 2022. Senior Judge Mary Beth Bonaventura has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore, in the Marion Superior Court 15, beginning on February 7, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Mary Beth Bonaventura is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in the Marion Superior Court 15, effective February 7, 2022, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Bonaventura to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Marion Superior Court 15 until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Bonaventura shall be entitled to compensation for her service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of her appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
