Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

Judge Lance D. Hamner of the Johnson Superior Court 3, notified this Court that he has resigned from the bench effective February 3, 2022. Senior Judge Jeffrey C. Eggers has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore, in the Johnson Superior Court 3, beginning on February 7, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Jeffrey C. Eggers is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in Johnson Superior Court 3, effective February 7, 2022, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Eggers to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of Johnson Superior Court 3 until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Eggers shall be entitled to compensation for his service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
