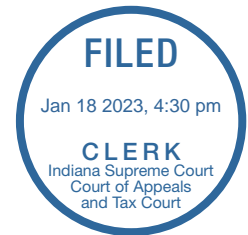

Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

Judge Dana J. Kenworthy, of Grant Superior Court 2, has been appointed to the Indiana Court of Appeals. Judge Kenworthy notified this court that she intends to begin her service on the Indiana Court of Appeals on January 17, 2023. Senior Judge Marianne L. Vorhees has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in Grant Superior Court 2 beginning on January 30, 2023.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Marianne L. Vorhees is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in Grant Superior Court 2, effective January 30, 2023, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Vorhees to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of Grant Superior Court 2 until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Vorhees shall be entitled to compensation for her service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of her appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
