## Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

Marion County Court Administration has notified this Court that the Honorable Shatrese M. Flowers passed away on November 5, 2023. Senior Judge Jane S. Craney has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore, in the Marion Superior Court – Criminal Division 28, beginning on December 6, 2023.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Indiana Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Jane S. Craney is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in Marion Superior Court – Criminal Division 28, effective December 6, 2023, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Craney to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of Marion Superior Court – Criminal Division 28 until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Craney shall be entitled to compensation for her service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of her appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
