Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable Michael J. Kramer, Judge of the Noble Circuit Court, passed away on March 28, 2025. Senior Judge Kevin Wallce has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore, in the Noble Circuit Court, beginning on April 14, 2025.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Indiana Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Kevin Wallace is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in the Noble Circuit Court effective April 14, 2025, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Wallace to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Noble Circuit Court until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Wallace shall be entitled to compensation for his service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
