Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable Andrew R. Bloch, Judge of the Hamilton Circuit Court, has notified this Court that there is a need for assistance with coverage of a docket previously managed by a magistrate. Senior Judge Amanda L. Yonally has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore beginning on September 9, 2026.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Indiana Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Yonally is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in Hamilton Circuit Court, effective September 9, and shall remain as Judge Pro Tempore until further order of this Court.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Senior Judge Yonally to discharge the full-time magistrate duties as assigned by Judge Bloch until further order of this Court. Senior Judge Yonally shall be entitled to compensation for her service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
