Order

On May 16, 2019 the Indiana Supreme Court adopted the Commercial Court Rules for the Indiana Commercial Courts. Commercial Court Rule 4(D) was missing a critical word that can be found in **bold** below.

Rule 4. Assignment of Case to the Commercial Court Docket

....

(D) If an Identifying Notice is filed by the party initiating the case and no other party has appeared in the case: (1) the clerk of the court shall assign the case to the Commercial Court Docket, which assignment is deemed a provisional assignment; (2) if no Refusal Notice is timely filed by any party that has appeared in the case, the assignment of the case is deemed permanent; and (3) if a Refusal Notice is timely filed, the clerk shall transfer and assign the case to the **non**-Commercial Court Docket of the Commercial Court judge.

....

This Court now amends its May 16, 2019 order to include this correction.
