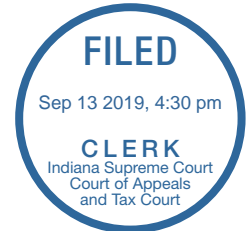

Order Appointing Committee Members

The Judges and Lawyers Assistance Program (“JLAP”) provides confidential assistance to judges, lawyers, and law students experiencing any issue which may impact their quality of life or ability to practice law. The JLAP Committee oversees JLAP’s work. The Supreme Court appoints the members of the JLAP Committee. *See*, Indiana Admission and Discipline Rule 31.

The terms of the Honorable Stephen Heimann, U.S. Magistrate Judge Tim Baker, and Mr. David Sanders as members of the JLAP Committee will expire on December 31, 2019. Further, the Court is informed that member Ms. Cassandra McNair is unable to complete her term that will expire on December 31, 2021. The Court thanks Judges Heimann and Baker, and Mr. Sanders and Ms. McNair for their service.

To replace Judge Heimann, the Court hereby appoints the Honorable Darrin Dolehanty, to replace U.S. Magistrate Judge Baker, the Court hereby appoints U.S. Magistrate Judge Matthew Brookman, to replace Mr. David Sanders, the Court hereby appoints Ms. Teresa McKeethen, and to replace Ms. Cassandra McNair, the Court hereby appoints Ms. Angka Hinshaw. Judge Dolehanty, Magistrate Judge Brookman, and Ms. McKeethen shall serve terms commencing January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2022, or when a successor is appointed. Ms. Hinshaw shall complete the term of Ms. McNair ending December 31, 2021 and shall serve a term in her own right commencing January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2024, or when a successor is appointed.

Further, the Court hereby reappoints The Honorable Marc Kellams, Ms. Inge Van der Cruysse, and Mr. Robert William Jonas, Jr. to terms commencing January 1, 2020 and expiring December 31, 2022, or when a successor is appointed.
