Indiana Legal Services, Inc., Prosperity Indiana, Neighborhood Christian Legal Clinic, Indianapolis Legal Aid Society, Pro Bono Indiana, Inc., and Indiana Institute for Working Families petition this Court to (1) extend parts of its April 20, 2020 order related to stimulus payments under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security ("CARES") Act to stimulus payments under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021; and (2) consider postponing the current July 1, 2021 expiration date for the April 20, 2020 order. The Court has reviewed the pending petition. Each Justice has had the opportunity to voice that Justice's views on this matter in conference with the other Justices, and each has voted on the petition.

Being duly advised, the Court DENIES the "Petition to Extend Protections Against Garnishment to Stimulus Payments under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021."
