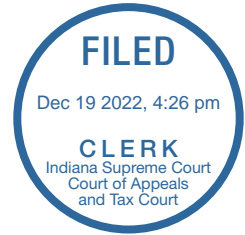

Order Amending Administrative Rules

Under the authority vested in this Court to provide by rule for the procedures employed in all courts of this state and this Court's inherent authority to supervise the administration of all courts of this state, the Indiana Administrative Rules are amended as follows (deletions shown by ~~striketrough~~ and new text shown by underlining):

Rule 8. Uniform Case Numbering System

...

(B) Numbering System. ...

...

- (1) Court Identifier. The last two characters of the first group shall distinguish between courts in counties having more than one court of a specific type. The following code sets forth the county and court identifier for all courts:

...

06I01 Boone/Thorntown Town Court (abolished effective December 31, 2022)

...

48I01 Madison/Edgewood Town Court (abolished effective December 31, 2021)

...

- (3) Case type. The third group of two characters shall designate the type of proceeding utilizing the following case classification code:

Civil Case Types

...

RF-- Warrantless seizure of firearm from individual believed to be dangerous (for affidavits filed under I.C. 35-47-14-3 Indiana's "red flag" law)



Criminal Case Types

RF-- Warrant to search for and seize a firearm in possession of dangerous individual (for affidavits filed under I.C. 35-47-14-2 Indiana's "red flag" law)
