

Proposed Amendments to Indiana Jury Rules and Rules on Access to Court Records
(August 2026)

* The proposed amendment to Jury Rule 10 would add language to enhance privacy of jurors and prospective jurors. The proposed amendment to Access to Court Records Rule 7(B) would revise the cross-reference to Jury Rule 10.

Jury Rules

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Rule 10. Juror Safety and Privacy

(a) Jury questionnaires and jury summonses are excluded from public access.

(b) Personal information about a juror or prospective juror not disclosed in open court is excluded from public access.

(c) Unless otherwise ordered by the court, A court may order sensitive information provided by a juror or prospective juror during an individual voir dire held outside the presence of other members of the jury panel or during a side bar interview is excluded from public access.

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Rules on Access to Court Records

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Rule 7: Procedures for Excluding Exhibits and Testimony From Public Access.

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(B) Transcript and Exhibits on Appeal.

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(2) Any *in camera* discussions during a hearing or trial, pursuant to that includes information excluded under Jury Rule 10 must ~~shall~~ be excluded in its entirety from Public Access when included in the transcript on appeal.

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
