Certification of Appellate Opinions and Memorandum Decisions

Appellate Rule 65(E)

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When the appellate courts issue opinions or memorandum decisions, the Appellate Clerk sends copies to the parties and trial court. However, **the trial court and parties shall not take any action in reliance upon the opinion or memorandum decision until the opinion or memorandum decision is certified.**

A certified opinion or memorandum decision is sent by the Appellate Clerk to the trial court only after the time for all petitions for rehearing or transfer have expired. A grace period is given before certification to account for filings that may be delayed by mail. The Clerk of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals and Tax Court electronically transmits the certified opinion or memorandum decision.

Return of the certification receipt to the Clerk of the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals and Tax Court is no longer required.
